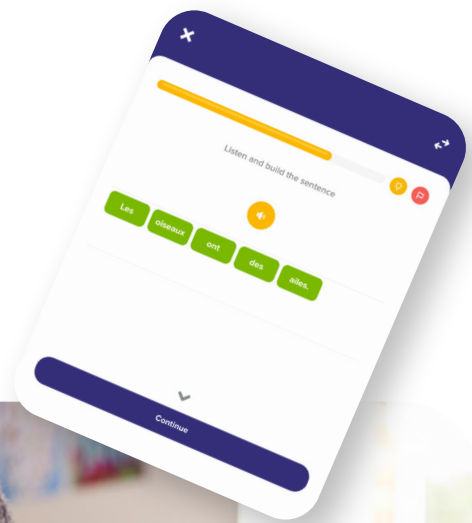

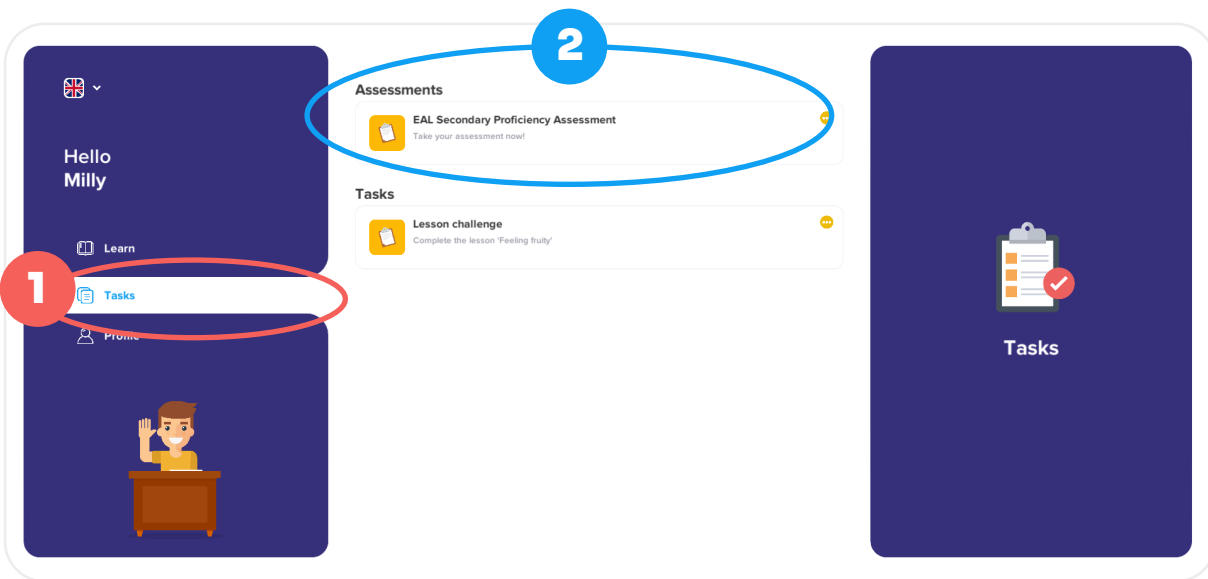
- 1 Select 'Learn' to find all your lessons.

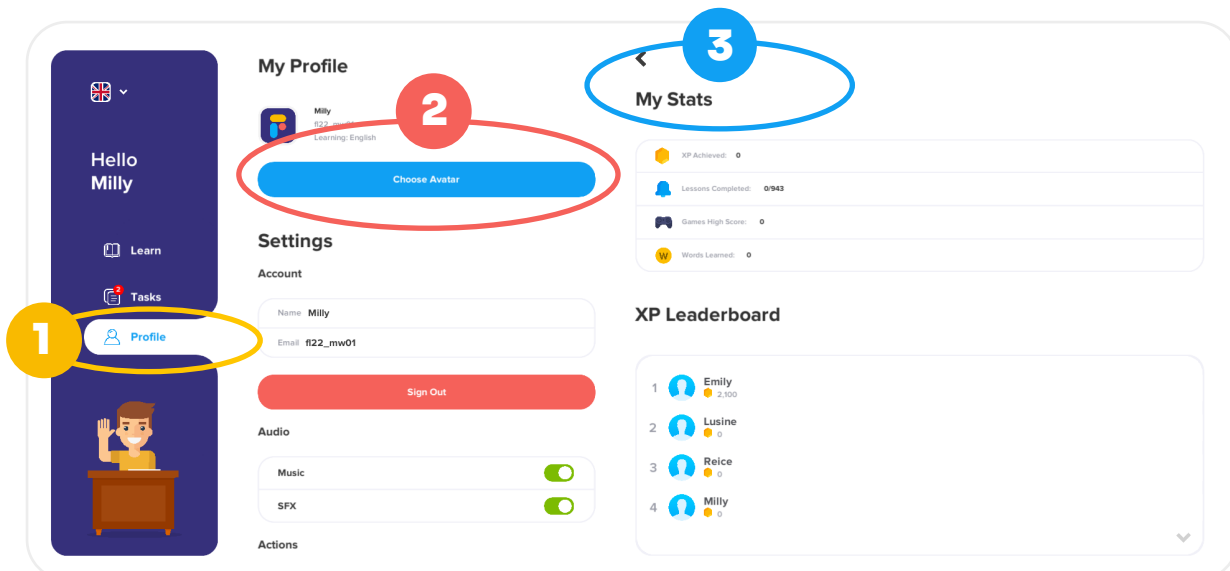

- 2 This is also where you will find the assessment once it has been set for you.



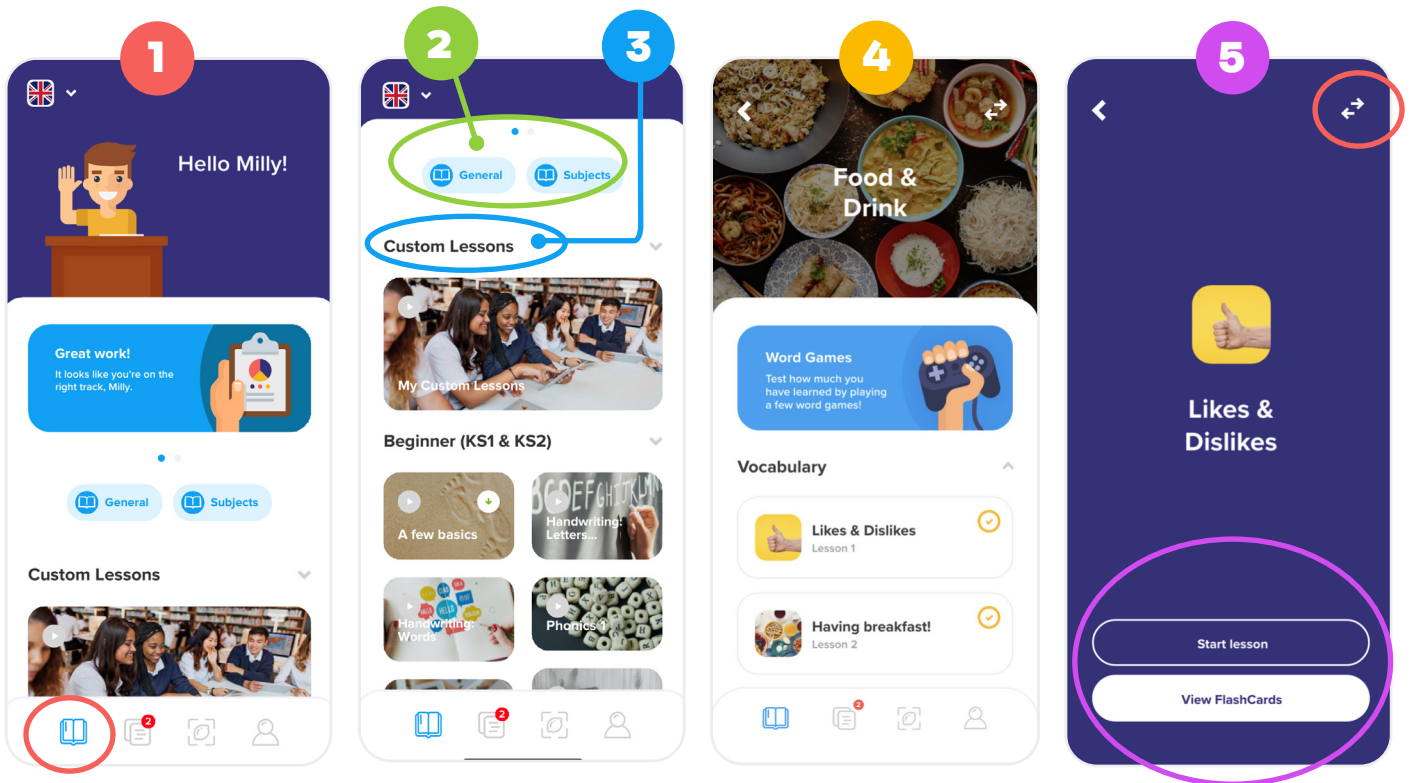

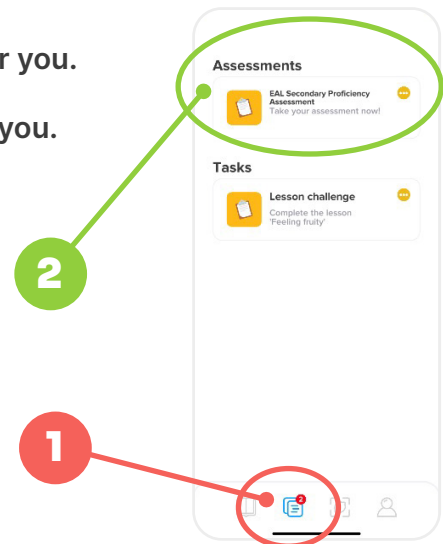
- 1 Select 'Learn' to find all your lessons.

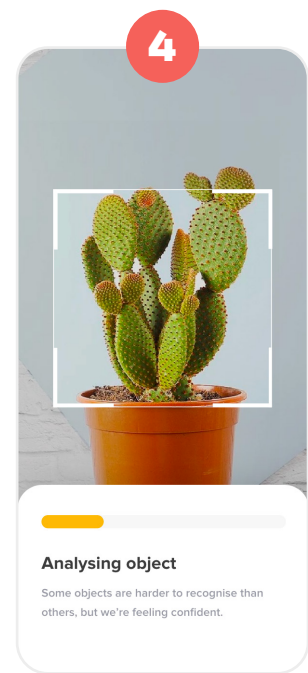
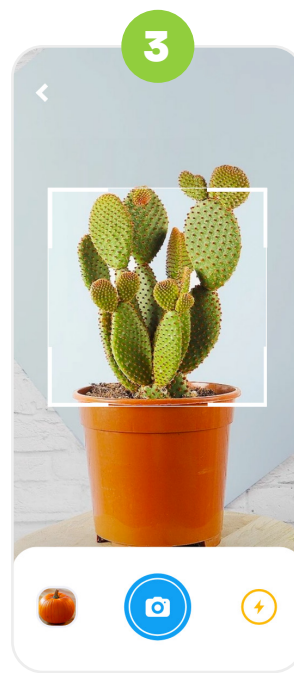
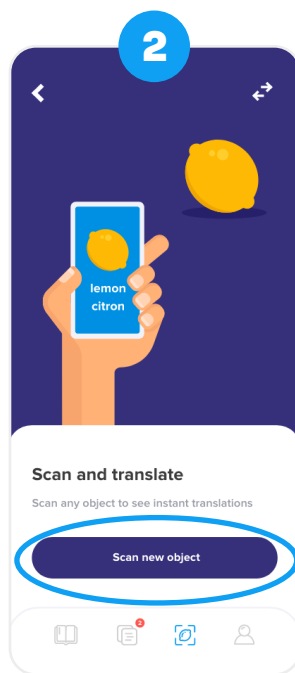
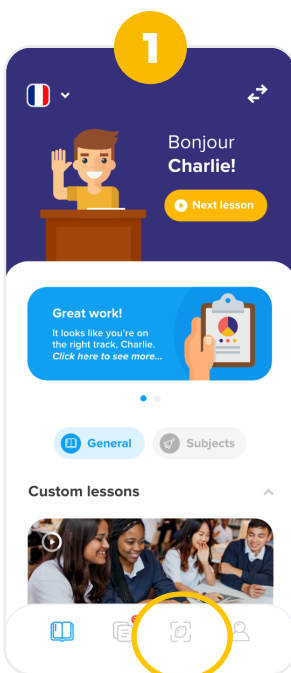
Tasks

- 2 This is also where you will find any assessments set for you.



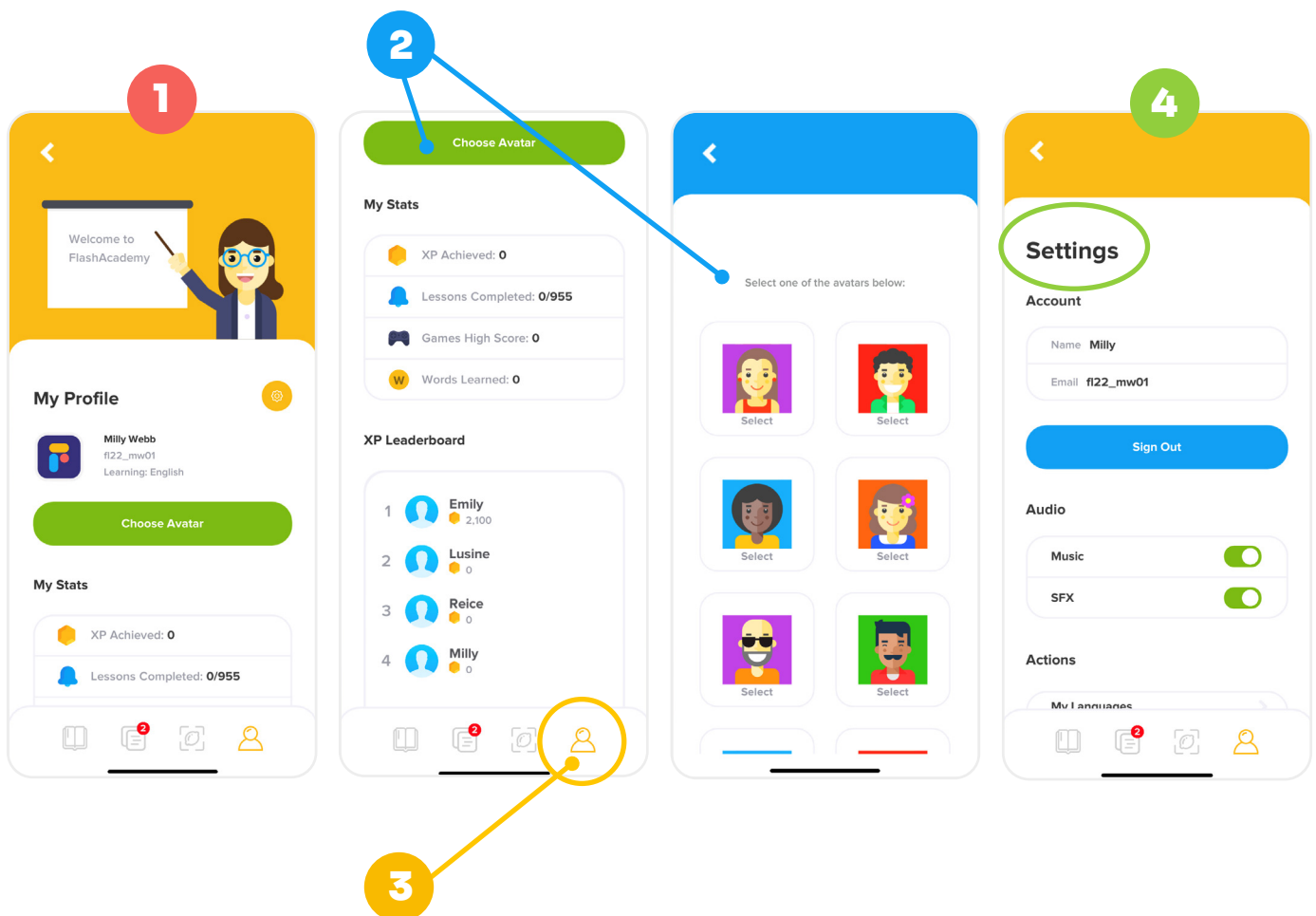
Object Translator

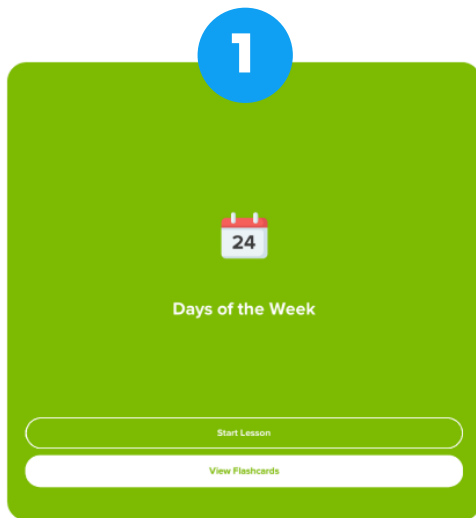

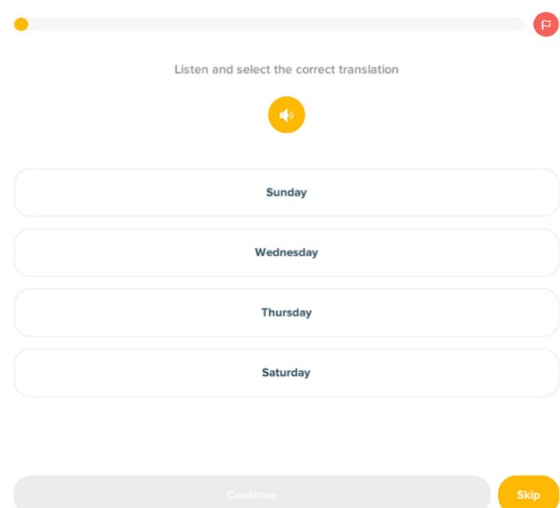
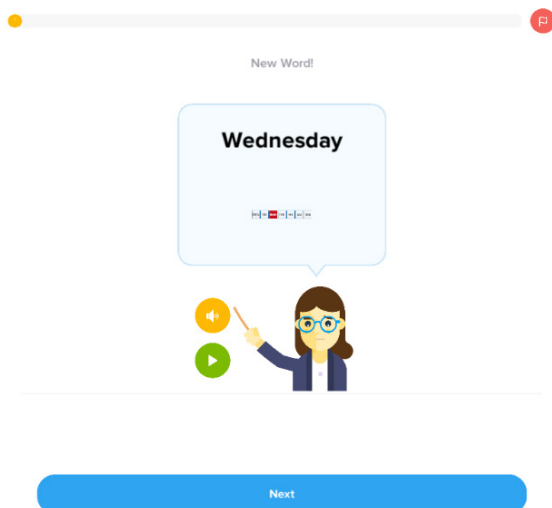
Lessons and Flashcards

You will have access to all lessons; You do not have to complete them in any particular order. Lessons can be repeated as many times as you like.



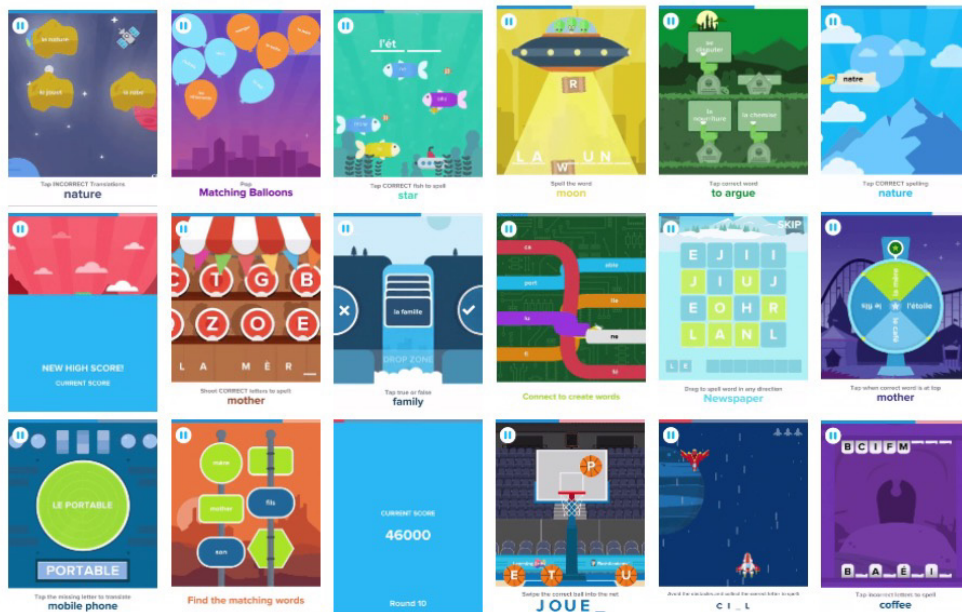
